You are receiving this notice because you were registered as and Interested & Affected Party (I&AP) and/or participated in the previous EIA processes or have registered in response to the Advert or Site notice for this proposed access road. Should you wish to no longer participate in this environmental process, kindly inform Cape EAPrac and we will remove you from the database:

Cape EAPrac have been appointed by Grootfontein Access Road (Pty) Ltd to facilitate an application for Environmental Authorisation for the Proposed Grootfontein Access Road on the Remainder and Portion 5 of the Farm Grootfontein Number 149 Situated near Touws River in the Western Cape Province.

Grootfontein Access Road (Pty) Ltd intend on constructing an access road on Remainder and Portion 5 of the Farm Grootfontein number 149, in the Witzenberg Local Municipality of the Western Cape Province. The purpose of the access road is to provide access to three authorised Photovoltaic (PV) energy generation facilities, known as Grootfontein PV1, Grootfontein PV2 and Grootfontein PV2 on the portion 5 and the Remainder of Farm Grootfontein 149. These three projects were selected as preferred bidders in Round 5 of the Department of Energy's (DOE) Renewable Energy Independent Power Producers Procurement Programme (REIPPPP). Please refer to Appendix L for confirmation that the project was selected as a preferred bidder under the REIPPPP and designated as a Strategic Integrated Project in terms of the National Infrastructure Plan. It must be noted that each of these authorised facilities (Grootfontein PV1, Grootfontein PV2 and Grootfontein PV3) have an access road authorised in their respective EA's. Grootfontein Access Road (Pty) Ltd propose the construction of a single access road to access all three of these facilities instead of the three access roads already authorised. The proposed road (within the assessed corridor) would have a maximum width of 12 metres (inclusive of side drains and gravel embankments). The road would have a gravel surface constructed to NGL, however, it will only be known at detailed design phase should any portions of the road require concrete surfacing or other wearing course. In the event that any concrete surfacing is required, this will be completed in line with the environmental management programme as approved by the DEA&DP.

The Draft Basic Assessment Report for the abovementioned project is available to all registered Interested and Affected Parties (I&AP's) for a 30 day comment period extending from <u>04 May 2023 – 03 June 2023</u>.
