PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PROCESS FOR PARKDENE FILLING STATION ON ERF 11221 PARKDENE, GEORGE

Notice is hereby given of a Public Participation Process in terms of the National Environmental Management Act (NEMA, Act No 107 of 1998 as amended)

An application for **Amendment of the Environmental Authorisation (EA)** and Environmental Management Programme (EMPr) has been submitted to the Department of Environmental Affairs and Development Planning (DEAD&DP) as the competent authority for decision making.

The Parkdene Filling Station was granted Environmental Authorisation (EA), on 14 November 2012, with a validity period of 5-years. The 5-year validity period was extended by an additional 5-years, on 21 August 2017, via Addendum to the EA. The pre-construction requirements of the Site Licence issued by the Department of Mineral Resources & Energy could not commence before the revised EA lapse date (14 November 2022).

Proposal: The Holder of the EA / Applicant proposes to **extend the validity period** of the Environmental Authorisation to **change the layout / orientation** of the Filling Station Site Development Plan in accordance to marketing best practice and with due consideration of the site limitations.
