## RE: AMENDMENT OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATION REF: 16/3/1/1/D2/50/0060/12 ISSUED ON 14 MARCH 2014: BULK SERVICES UPGRADE PIPELINE REALIGNMENT ON ERF 5006, PORTION 40/197, PORTION 50/197 AND PORTION 58/197, THEMBALETHU, GEORGE

**Cape Environmental Assessment Practitioners** (*Cape EAPrac*) are appointed by the Holder of the Environmental Authorisation (EA) **George Municipality**, to apply for an amendment of the bulk sewer pipeline route traversing Erf 5006, Portion 40/197 and Portion 50/197.

The original EIA was issued on 14 March 2014, with subsequent amendments to the Environmental Management Programme (EMP), approved on 17 November 2021.

The DEA&DP considered a formal Part 2 Amendment Application to realign a short section of approximately 1000m of the approved pipeline route traversing Erf 5006, Portion 40/197 and Portion 50/197 as well as additional erosion protection measures on Portion 58/197. On 13 February 2025 the DEA&DP **authorised/approved** the amendment application.

A copy of the EA, explaining, the reasons for the decision, is included with this notification for your information and record purposes. The document is also available on the Cape EAPrac website (<a href="https://www.cape-eaprac.co.za">www.cape-eaprac.co.za</a>).

In terms of **Condition B(1)** of the Amended EA, we hereby notify all registered I&APs that participated in the original environmental investigation process, of the outcome of this amendment application process and its decision. ## <u>APPEAL PROCEDURE in accordance with Regulation 4 of the National Appeal Regulations</u> <u>2014 (as amended)</u>

In terms of **Section C** of the Amended EA, should any party (who is not the Holder of the EA), intend to appeal this decision, a formal **Appeal** must be submitted to the Appeal Administrator (the Western Cape Ministry of Local Government, Environmental Affairs and

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Development Planning) in terms of **Regulation 4 of the National Appeal Regulations**, within **20 calendar days from the date of this notification** of the Amendment To Environmental Authorisation.

In such a case, you are required to submit a copy of the Appeal to the decision-maker (the Competent Authority that issued the decision), this office (Cape EAPrac), the holder of the decision, all registered I&APs and any Organ of State with interest in this matter.
