Notice is hereby given of a Public Participation Process in terms of the National Environmental Management Act (Act No. 107 of 1998) and the National Heritage Resources Act (NHRA) (No. 25 of 1999).

An Application for a Scoping & Environmental Impact Reporting (SEIR) process will be submitted to the national Department of Environmental Affairs (DEA) as the competent authority for decision making.

Proposition: AND WIND HOTAZEL PV (PV) L31
Environmental Consultant: Cape EAPrac
Location: Farm Vols A278, situated South of Hotazel in the Northern Cape.

Proposed: It is the intention of the proponent, as a Renewable Energy Independent Power Producer (REIP) to develop a 25MW (Megawatt) Solar Photovoltaic (PV) Facility, with associated infrastructure: on-site substation, auxiliary buildings, access & internal roads, overhead electrical transmission lines, perimeter fencing.
